- **Picnic Table & Swivel Chairs**, which are sandblasted, primed, and powder-coated in a choice of choice of eight different standard colors (or custom colors upon request). The table, which is 88" x 88", features a 2-1/2" diameter umbrella hole with an umbrella base, and chairs mounted on swivel bases. ADA options are available
- **Picnic Table with Standard Benches** are sandblasted, primed, and powder-coated in a choice of choice of eight different standard colors (or custom colors upon request). The table is 72" x 31"; benches are 72" long. ADA options are available
- **The Receptacle**, ideal for outdoor trash or recycling, is sandblasted, primed, and powder-coated in a choice of eight different standard colors (or custom colors upon request) and features a 32-gallon rigid liner and a detachable aluminum lid

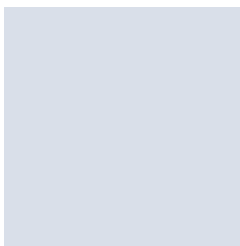
environmentally friendly and cost-effective.
